5	<u>PROGRESS REPORT ON PROJECTS</u>	<u>ACTION</u>
	<p>The proposed projects were then updated.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="331 319 1026 386">1 <u>Late Night Shopping /Christmas Market</u> It was AGREED not to pursue this project until 2011. <li data-bbox="331 424 1354 592">2 <u>Easter Event</u> This project was still a possibility if the funding became available, but there had been no discussion as yet at any meeting of the Chamber of Commerce & Tourism. Sainsbury was due to open on the 15th February 2011 and so the S106 monies should be forthcoming for the Easter Event. <li data-bbox="331 630 1354 831">3 <u>Christmas / Summer – French Market/ German Market, Market day and Late Night Shopping</u> The Chamber of Commerce & Tourism was investigating these projects. The Hythe Twinning Association and Shepway District Council’s Town Centre Manager, Mr John Barber, were to be approached via the Chamber in respect of overseas markets. <li data-bbox="331 869 889 936">4 <u>Hythe Festival – High Street Events</u> This project would be considered for 2012. <li data-bbox="331 974 1354 1113">5 <u>Hythe Venetian Fete – PR Material</u> Mr Ben Geering to be requested to provide details of dates for when the S106 would come on stream. The costings and preparation of the leaflets were to be provided by the Hythe Venetian Fete Society. <li data-bbox="331 1150 1354 1352">6 <u>Road Pavement / Street Lighting Improvements</u> Kent Highways had installed new lights opposite Sainsbury’s on Military Road. There was a need to appraise what lighting was required for the linking of Military Road and the High Street and associated pavement improvements. The junction at Red Lion Square also required improvement and this was to be looked at by the S106 Group Members. <li data-bbox="331 1390 1354 1491">7 <u>Public Realm Improvements</u> A quote had been provided for ladder signs but it had been deemed too expensive and an update was required. <li data-bbox="331 1528 1260 1596">8 <u>Decorative Lighting in the High Street/Red Lion Square/Mackeson Court</u> An update was required from Jeremy Whittaker. <li data-bbox="331 1633 1354 1835">9 <u>Decorative Banners</u> Members of the Group were to have a site meeting to assess where the decorative banners could be hung, together with street furnishings improvements and the road layout. Dates were to be obtained from Jeremy Whittaker and Ben Geering to ascertain when they would be available. The week commencing the 10th – 15th January 2011 was suggested. <li data-bbox="331 1873 1354 1999">10 <u>Passenger Boat Service, Royal Military Canal</u> This project was already being dealt with separately.
